originally published in 1991 this volume tackles the diverse teachings of the great psychoanalyst and theoretician written by some of the leading american and european lacanian scholars and practitioners the essays attempt to come to terms with his complex relation to the culture of contemporary psychoanalysis the volume presents useful insights into lacan s innovative theories on the nature of language and the subject many of the essays probe the importance of psychoanalysis for problems of signifier and referent in the philosophy of language others explore the difficulties men and women have in negotiating the sexual differences that divide them a major contribution to the new reception of jacques lacan in the english speaking world lacan and the subject of language will challenge those who believe that they have already mastered lacanian thought the insights offered here will pave the way for further developments

jacques lacan continues to be subject to the most extravagant interpretations angelic to some he is demonic to others to recall lacan s career now that the heroic age of psychoanalysis is over is to remember an intellectual and literary adventure that occupies a founding place in our modernity lacan went against the current of many of the hopes aroused by 1968 but embraced their paradoxes and his language games and wordplay resonate today as so many injunctions to replace rampant individualism with a heightened social consciousness widely recognized as the leading authority on lacan lisabeth roudinesco revisits his life and work what it was and what it remains

lacan postulated that the psyche can be understood by means of certain structures which control our lives and our desires and which operate differently at different logical moments or stages of formation jacques lacan and the logic of structure offers us a reading of the major concepts of lacan in terms of his later topological theory and aims to show how this was always a concern for lacan and not only an issue in the last seminars ellie ragland discusses how various stages of formation can be uncovered topologically within

language itself and operate to place certain properties fantasy the drive jouissance discourse and ethics in language itself in this way she explores not only how language actually works in tandem with the properties but also gives a different idea of what knowledge actually is and what implications that may have for reimagining and reworking differential diagnostic structures jacques lacan and the logic of structure is a compelling exponent of the innovative approaches lacan takes to rethinking what psychoanalysis is and what it can do to enlighten psychoanalysts and treat patients it will be essential reading to psychoanalysts psychoanalytic psychotherapists training graduate students in the fields of film literary gender and cultural studies

how did lacan develop his ideas how do they affect everyday clinical realities jacques lacan s work has become a standard reference in gender women s and cultural studies yet despite its popularity is frequently being debunked as an impenetrable postmodernist discourse jacques lacan and the freudian practice of psychoanalysis paints a completely new picture of the man and his ideas situating lacan s contributions firmly within the freudian tradition of clinical psychoanalysis the book succeeds in showing how his ideas can become more accessible and re evaluates his significance within the field of psychodynamic psychotherapy the book is structured thematically around five key issues diagnosis the analyst s position during the treatment the management of transference the formulation of interpretations and the organisation of analytic training for each of these issues lacan s entire work both published and unpublished material has been taken into account and theoretical principles have been illustrated with clinical examples the book also contains the first complete bibliography of lacan s works in english clear detailed and wide ranging jacques lacan and the freudian practice of psychoanalysis will prove essential reading not only for professionals and students within the fields of psychology psychiatry and psychotherapy but for all those keen to discover a new lacan

if catherine clément took to writing the lives and legends of jacques lacan it was not only to reconnect with her lost youth it was an

act of fidelity she set out to portray her own private lacan the figure she kept behind other people's gloss and commentary

this bibliography in two volumes originally published in 1988 lists and describes works by and about jacques lacan published in french english and seven other languages including japanese and russian it incorporates and corrects where necessary all information from earlier published bibliographies of lacan's work also included as background works are books and essays that discuss lacan in the course of a more general study as well as all relevant items in various bibliographic sources from many fields

jacques lacan 1901 1980 is undoubtedly the central figure of psychoanalysis in the second half of the 20th century the texts selected here present the entire scope of the lacan debate

this book provides the first truly sustained commentary to appear in either french or english on lacan's most important seminar the four fundamental concepts of psychoanalysis the 16 contributors unpack lacan's notoriously difficult work in simple terms and supply elegant illustrations from a variety of fields psychoanalytic treatment film literature art and so on each of lacan's fundamental concepts the unconscious transference drive and repetition is discussed in detail and related to other important notions such as object a cause of desire the gaze the name of the father the subject and the other this volume also includes a translation of lacan's companion piece to seminar xi position of the unconscious an article from the french edition of the *écrits* that has never before appeared in english by one of the foremost translators of lacan's work bruce fink as an indication of the importance of this article lacan considered it to be the sequel to his function and field of speech and language in psychoanalysis arguably his most important paper in the 1950s the contributors include many of the best minds in the lacanian psychoanalytic world in paris today chapters include excommunication context and concepts by jacques alain miller the subject and the other i and ii by colette soler alienation and separation i and ii by eric laurent science and psychoanalysis by bruce fink the name of the father by francois regnault transference as deception by pierre

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jacques lacan the basics provides a clear and succinct introduction to the work of jacques lacan one of the key thinkers of the twentieth century lacan s ideas are applied in the study of the humanities politics and psychology as well as contemporary media and the arts but their complexity makes them impenetrable to many this book is unique in explaining the key concepts and context from lacan s understanding of psychoanalysis to drive and desire in an accessible way without diluting them beyond meaning examples from popular culture are used throughout to emphasise the ideas being discussed and a full glossary and list of resources for further reading encourages additional exploration this engaging and accessible text is essential reading for all those interested in lacan and his work as well as students of psychology psychoanalysis literature politics cultural studies film studies and more

from 1953 to 1980 jacques lacan sought to accomplish a return to freud beyond post freudianism he defined this return as a new covenant with the meaning of the freudian discovery each year through his teaching he brought about this return what was at stake

in this renewal

the title is just the first of many startling asides observations and insights that fill this guide to hollywood on the lacanian psychoanalyst s couch zizek introduces the ideas of jacques lacan through the medium of american film taking his examples from over 100 years of cinema from charlie chaplin to the matrix and referencing along the way such figures as lenin and hegel michel foucault and jesus christ enjoy your symptom is a thrilling guide to cinema and psychoanalysis from a thinker who is perhaps the last standing giant of cultural theory in the twenty first century

this work traces the development of lacan s thinking on the role of the mother in psychical formation it shows that the mother occupies a key position in the lacanian project widely held to emphasize the paternal dimension of human subjectivity

if psychoanalysis is a science lacan suggests it may be surprisingly similar to linguistics we need to clarify the meanings of the four fundamental concepts the drive repetition the unconsciousness and transference

in his famous seminar on ethics jacques lacan uses this question as his departure point for a re examination of freud s work and the experience of psychoanalysis in relation to ethics delving into the psychoanalyst s inevitable involvement with ethical questions lacan clarifies many of his key concepts during the seminar he discusses the problem of sublimation the paradox of jouissance the essence of tragedy and the tragic dimension of analytical experience one of the most influential french intellectuals of this century lacan is seen here at the height of his powers

jacques lacan one of the most influential and controversial french thinkers of the twentieth century was a practicing and teaching

psychoanalyst in paris but his revolutionary seminars on freud reached out far beyond professional circles they were enthusiastically attended by writers artists scientists philosophers and intellectuals from many disciplines shoshana felman elucidates the power and originality of lacan s work she brilliantly analyzes lacan s investigation of psychoanalysis not as dogma but as an ongoing self critical process of discovery by focusing on lacan s singular way of making freud s thought new again and of thus enabling us to participate in the very moment of intellectual struggle and insight felman shows how this moment of illumination has become crucial to contemporary thinking and has redefined insight as such this book is a groundbreaking statement not only on lacan but on psychoanalysis in general felman argues that contrary to popular opinion lacan s preoccupation is with psychoanalytic practice rather than with theory for its own sake his true clinical originality consists not in the incidental innovations that separate his theory from other psychoanalytic schools but in the insight he gives us into the structural foundations of what is common to the practice of all schools the transference ation and the psychoanalytic dialogue in chapters on poe s tale the purloined letter sophocles oedipus plays a case report by melanie klein and freud s writings felman demonstrates lacan s ediscovery of these texts as renewed and renewable intellectual adventures and as parables of the psychoanalytic encounter the book explores these questions how and why does psychoanalytic practice work what accounts for clinical success what did freud learn from the literary oedipus and how does freud text take us beyond oedipus how does psychoanalysis inform and radically displace our conception of what learning is and of what reading is this book will be an intellectual event not only for clinicians and literary critics but also for the broader audience of readers interested in contemporary thought

what does lacan show us he shows us that desire is not a biological function that it is not correlated with a natural object and that its object is fantasized because of this desire is extravagant it cannot be grasped by those who might try to master it it plays tricks on them yet if it is not recognized it produces symptoms in psychoanalysis the goal is to interpret that is to read the message regarding

desire that is harbored within the symptom although desire upsets us it also inspires us to invent artifices that can serve us as a compass an animal species has a single natural compass human beings on the other hand have multiple compasses signifying montages and discourses they tell you what to do how to think how to enjoy and how to reproduce yet each person's fantasy remains irreducible to shared ideals up until recently all of our compasses no matter how varied pointed in the same direction toward the father we considered the patriarch to be an anthropological invariant his decline accelerated owing to increasing equality the growth of capitalism and the ever greater domination of technology we have reached the end of the father age another discourse is in the process of taking the former's place it champions innovation over tradition networks over hierarchies the draw of the future over the weight of the past femininity over virility where there had previously been a fixed order transformational flows constantly push back any and all limits freud was a product of the father age he did a great deal to save it the catholic church finally realized this lacan followed the way paved by freud but it led him to posit that the father is a symptom he demonstrates that here using hamlet as an example what people have latched onto about lacan's work his formalization of the oedipus complex and his emphasis on the name of the father was merely his point of departure seminar vi already revises this the oedipus complex is not the only solution to desire it is merely a normalized form thereof it is moreover a pathogenic form it does not exhaustively explain desire's course hence the eulogy of perversion with which this seminar ends lacan views perversion here as a rebellion against the identifications that assure the maintenance of social routines this seminar predicted the revamping of formally established conformisms and even their explosion we have reached that point lacan is talking about us

during the third year of his famous seminar jacques lacan gives a concise definition of psychoanalysis psychoanalysis should be the science of language inhabited by the subject from the freudian point of view man is the subject captured and tortured by language since psychosis is a special but emblematic case of language entrapment lacan devotes much of this year to grappling with distinctions

between the neuroses and the psychoses as he compared the two relationships symmetries and contrasts emerge that enable him to erect a structure for psychosis freud s famous case of daniel paul schreber is central to lacan s analysis in demonstrating the many ways that the psychotic is inhabited possessed by language lacan draws upon schreber s own account of his psychosis and upon freud s notes on this case of paranoia the analysis of language is both fascinating and enlightening

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
